CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entries are accepted subject to the General Rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies (QCAS) and to the Constitution and Rules of the Sarina Show Society in addition to any Special Regulations which appear within this schedule.
2. Every care will be taken with exhibits, but the Society shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits while at the Show or in transit to and from the grounds.
3. All entries close on the date shown above.
4. No exhibit can be removed before 9am on Sunday 2nd August, 2026, without permission of the Steward in charge of the relevant section.
5. All exhibits must have been grown by the exhibitor in whose name they are entered.
6. An exhibit that has won a prize at a previous Sarina Show is not eligible for entry.
7. Competitors are restricted to two (2) entries per class.
8. Each exhibit must be clearly marked with the entrant's name, section and class. This information can be printed from Showday Online at the time of placing your entry online.
9. Exhibits entered in the incorrect class may be transferred to the proper class by the Steward and/or Judge.
10. No exhibitors shall be permitted to remain in the pavilion during judging.
11. The Judge may at their discretion, refuse to award a prize where an exhibit is deemed by them to be not of sufficient merit.
12. The Judge's decision will be final.
13. All prizes not claimed by 31st August, 2026 will become a donation to the Sarina Show Society.
14. Stewards and/or their immediate family members are permitted to enter exhibits in competition. All entries are judged anonymously to ensure fairness and impartiality.
15. The Sarina Show Society reserves the right to substitute prize money for vouchers of the equivalent value.

While every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of this schedule, the Sarina Show Society reserves the right to correct any errors, omissions, or inaccuracies and to make amendments where necessary.

CUT FLOWER SECTION

HINTS:

- Foliage natural to blooms exhibited should not be removed.
- Leave stems as long as possible. They can be cut to size after being entered.
- Judging is on perfection of flower, straightness, freshness and freedom from insect infestation.
- Containers will be supplied by the Steward, unless otherwise specified.
- Roses - leave some foliage on, but no buds.
- Stem - can have one or more multiple flowers

All entries are to be submitted via Showday Online -
<https://showday.online/show/sarina>

1. Create a new account or login to your account using your previous details – if you have forgotten your password, please use the forgotten password feature.
2. Select SARINA SHOW SOCIETY INC.
3. Click on PLACE AN ENTRY
4. Click on INDIVIDUAL ENTRY
5. In Entrant Name select your Entrant from the drop down or click on ADD NEW to add a new entrant to your account.
* If clicking Add New fill out your Entrants name. Other fields are optional.
6. In EXHIBIT TYPE select INDOOR / DISPLAY.
7. Click on SELECT CLASS.
8. From the drop down choose the Section you would like to enter.
9. On the pop up tick the box to accept the entry notes for this section.
10. Click the PLUS symbol beside the section you are entering to expand to the classes.
11. Click on the class or classes you are entering to select them.
12. If entering multiple items into the same class, increase the QTY counter to reflect the number you would like to enter.
13. Fill out the items name in the Exhibition Name box if applicable eg. Painting name.
14. Fill in any additional information the show may require for this entry if asked.
15. Once all classes have been selected.

* Click on ADD ANOTHER ENTRY if you need to place more entries for this show and repeat this process.

* Click on FINISHED ADDING CLASSES if you do not need to place any more entries for this show.
16. On the next screen select any extra items you need that are available
17. Click on FINISHED ADDING EXTRAS once done.
18. Purchase Membership if required or Pay your membership invoice if showing.
19. Click on FINISHED MEMBERSHIP once done.
20. Tick the box to agree to our website T&C's.
21. Click on payment type and enter any payment details as required.
