## Please Read Carefully

### SPECIAL POULTRY AND PIGEON REGULATIONS

For the conduct of Poultry and Caged Bird competitions at QCAS affiliated Queensland Agricultural Show.

Subject to the Rules, Bylaws and Regulations of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies Inc (QCAS) and the Sarina Show Society Inc. the following General Poultry and Pigeon Regulations shall apply.

These regulations are to be read in conjunction with the General Regulations contained in this schedule.

#### 1. NOTICE TO INTENDING EXHIBITORS

- Birds can only be removed from showing area with the permission of the Chief Steward.
- Any bird entered in the incorrect class, can at the discretion of the Chief Steward, be re-entered in the correct class.
- No birds are to be removed or handled without the Steward's permission.
- Any bird found to have been tampered with may, at the discretion of the Steward and committee, be disqualified.
- Eggs remain the property of the Sarina Show Society Inc.
- No trimming, plucking or dyeing of feathers, staining of legs or any fraudulent practice will be allowed.
- Every exhibitor will be deemed responsible for the condition in which his/her exhibit appears in the pen. It is permissible for exhibitors to dub male game fowl and game bantams.
- Birds must be true to breed, no cross breeds with the exception of the Pet Classes.
- Banded birds are eligible for judging.
- Junior exhibitors must pen and unpen their own entries.

#### 2. AGE OF EXHIBITS

- Birds 12 months and under will be judged as cockerel/pullet and birds over 12 months will be judged as cock/hen.

#### 3. JUDGING

- Judging standards will be those recognised by the Australian Standard or the British Poultry Standard where applicable.

- o Exhibitors are not to talk to judges during judging.
  - o Judges are not to judge classes in which they have entered.
  - o An exhibitor shall not compete nor show any bird in a section if the bird has been owned or leased by the judge or a member of the judge's immediate family or if the judge is the exhibitor's employer or business partner.
  - o An exhibitor shall not compete if the exhibitor or any bird being shown by the exhibitor has been given tuition by the judge or the judge's business partner within three (3) months prior to or during this show.
  - o An exhibitor is ineligible to compete if the exhibitor has employed or has been employed by or has been a business partner of the judge of the section three (3) months prior to or during the holding of this show.
  - o A judge shall not visit the bird-housing complex at the Sarina Show Society Inc, nor the owners, now inspect or discuss any animal entered in the show prior to or during the judging of the relevant section.
4. **BIOSECURITY**
- o All QCAS affiliated agricultural societies have developed a comprehensive Agricultural Show Biosecurity Plan and all event organisers, competitors and spectators have a joint responsibility to ensure the successful implementation of any biosecurity plan.

## **Regulations and Conditions of Entry**

1. Entries are accepted subject to the Rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies and Regulations of the Sarina Show Society Inc.
2. Classes will be formed for all breeds mentioned only where there are three (3) or more of a breed, otherwise exhibits will be placed in AOV/AOC classes. In AOV/AOC classes where there are three (3) or more exhibits or any one breed, separate classes will be provided for that breed.
3. Breed champions - where there are fourteen (14) or more exhibits of a breed, males or females will be judged separately for individual awards.
4. Only birds entered in single classes are eligible for single championships.
5. Only judges, stewards and adult exhibitors will be permitted in the pavilion during judging. Exhibitors are not to talk to judges during judging.
6. No person is permitted to handle or use judging sticks on any other exhibitor's birds, exhibitors can handle and use judging sticks on their own exhibits up to completion of penning birds. After completion of penning, no birds can be handled or have judging sticks used without the permission of the Chief Steward or judge. This rule is enforced most seriously and endorsed by the FCAW (Qld).
7. All birds are to be free of lice and disease.
8. No birds are allowed to have leg bands.
9. Exhibits must be the property of the exhibitor.
10. Any birds found to have been tampered with may, at the discretion of the Steward and committee be disqualified.
11. Birds can be penned between 2.00pm and 4.00pm on Friday 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2026 and 6.00am to 8.00am on Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2026. Birds are to be collected after 5.00pm on Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> August 2026, unless prior arrangements are made with the Chief Steward.
12. BIRDS CAN ONLY BE REMOVED FROM THE SHOWING AREA WITH PERMISSION OF THE CHIEF STEWARD.
13. Exhibitors with 20 or more entries will receive a free entry pass to the show. Entries must be in and paid for by Friday 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2026 to be eligible to receive a free entry pass.
14. All prizes not claimed by 31st August, 2026 will become a donation to the Sarina Show Society.
15. Stewards and/or their immediate family members are permitted to enter exhibits in competition. All entries are judged anonymously to ensure fairness and impartiality.
16. The Sarina Show Society reserves the right to substitute prize money for vouchers of the equivalent value.

While every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of this schedule, the Sarina Show Society reserves the right to correct any errors, omissions, or inaccuracies and to make amendments where necessary.
