Please Read Carefully

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entries are accepted subject to the General Rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies (QCAS) and to the Constitution and Rules of the Sarina Show Society in addition to any Special Regulations which appear within this schedule.
2. Every care will be taken with exhibits, but the Society shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits while at the Show or in transit to and from the grounds.
3. All entries close on the date shown above.
4. No exhibit can be removed before 9am on Sunday 2nd August, 2026, without permission of the Steward in charge of the relevant section.
5. All exhibits must have been baked/made by the exhibitor in whose name they are entered.
6. Competitors are restricted to two (2) entries per class.
7. Each exhibit must be clearly marked with the entrant's name, section and class. This information can be printed from Showday Online at the time of placing your entry online.
8. Exhibits entered in the incorrect class may be transferred to the proper class by the Steward and/or Judge.
9. No exhibitors shall be permitted to remain in the pavilion during judging.
10. The Judge may at their discretion, refuse to award a prize where an exhibit is deemed by them to be not of sufficient merit.
11. The Judge's decision will be final.
12. All prizes not claimed by 31st August, 2026 will become a donation to the Sarina Show Society.
13. Stewards and/or their immediate family members are permitted to enter exhibits in competition. All entries are judged anonymously to ensure fairness and impartiality.
14. The Sarina Show Society reserves the right to substitute prize money for vouchers of the equivalent value.

PACKAGING/DISPLAY OF ENTRIES

Packaging bakery items for the Show requires careful attention to detail to ensure items remain fresh and undamaged. The general rule is to protect the item from contamination while allowing the judge to see it, typically using clear, food-safe plastic.

· Disposable Plates and Boards: Entries to be exhibited on appropriate size firm, disposable paper or bamboo plate, (Use multiple plates if extra strength needed), foam tray or covered board where required, in CLEAR plastic bag (Clean oven bag or clear zip lock bag). If using an oven bag please close with a twist tie.

· NO: Glad wrap, cling wrap, thin plastic bags or supermarket veggie bags please.

· Sealable container: Alternatively, the use of clear lidded containers close to the size of the item is encouraged provided the plastic is transparent enough that the contents can be clearly seen without removal of the lid. Both disposable and non-disposable containers are permitted.

Non-disposable lidded containers such as large Tupperware or Sistema containers or similar, close to the size of the contents may be a good option for cakes and may if you wish be turned upside down making the lid the base. The cavity which normally holds the cake can then be clipped back onto the lid forming a sealed dome to protect the cake.

· Jams/Preserves: Use jars with screw-top lids, but do not use fabric covers. Jars must be clean and free of brand labels. Jars will be opened and tasted so please ensure opening will be possible.

Labels: Securely attach the provided exhibit/entry number to the front edge of the plate or board, not the plastic covering, as this is removed by stewards for judging.

All reasonable care of Exhibits including non-disposable containers, if you choose to use them, will be taken however no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage.

While every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of this schedule, the Sarina Show Society reserves the right to correct any errors, omissions, or inaccuracies and to make amendments where necessary.

RECIPE FOR FOUR EGG SPONGE

4 Eggs

3/4 cup Castor Sugar

55 grams butter

1 cup cornflour

3 teaspoons plain flour

1 teaspoon baking powder

Beat eggs until thick, gradually add sugar. Sift flour 3 times adding baking powder.

Fold flours into egg and sugar mixture. Then add melted butter. Bake at

190 degrees C for 20 to 25 minutes. Cake to be un-iced and joined with

cling wrap. Cook in two 18 cm round tins.

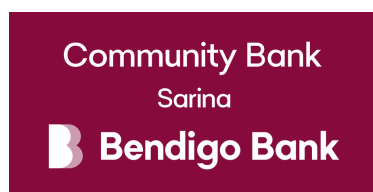

How to Enter the Pavilion Sections Online

All entries are to be submitted via Showday Online -
<https://showday.online/show/sarina>

1. Create a new account or login to your account using your previous details – if you have forgotten your password, please use the forgotten password feature.
2. Select SARINA SHOW SOCIETY INC.
3. Click on PLACE AN ENTRY
4. Click on INDIVIDUAL ENTRY
5. In Entrant Name select your Entrant from the drop down or click on ADD NEW to add a new entrant to your account.
* If clicking Add New fill out your Entrants name. Other fields are optional.
6. In EXHIBIT TYPE select INDOOR / DISPLAY.
7. Click on SELECT CLASS.
8. From the drop down choose the Section you would like to enter.
9. On the pop up tick the box to accept the entry notes for this section.
10. Click the PLUS symbol beside the section you are entering to expand to the classes.
11. Click on the class or classes you are entering to select them.
12. If entering multiple items into the same class, increase the QTY counter to reflect the number you would like to enter.
13. Fill out the items name in the Exhibition Name box if applicable eg. Painting name.
14. Fill in any additional information the show may require for this entry if asked.
15. Once all classes have been selected.

* Click on ADD ANOTHER ENTRY if you need to place more entries for this show and repeat this process.

* Click on FINISHED ADDING CLASSES if you do not need to place any more entries for this show.
16. On the next screen select any extra items you need that are available
.
17. Click on FINISHED ADDING EXTRAS once done.
18. Purchase Membership if required or Pay your membership invoice if showing.
19. Click on FINISHED MEMBERSHIP once done.
20. Tick the box to agree to our website T&C's.
21. Click on payment type and enter any payment details as required.
