CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entries are accepted subject to the General Rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies (QCAS) and to the Constitution and Rules of the Sarina Show Society in addition to any Special Regulations which appear within this schedule.
2. All cane must appear on the approved varieties list for Plane Creek mill area in the year of exhibition.
3. All exhibits to be annual plant or ratoon cane unless specified in the schedule. No standover cane to be entered.
4. The judging committee's decision will be final.
5. The growers names to be displayed only after the completion of judging.
6. All entries are to be properly presented and stripped NOT polished.
7. STALK entries must be cut level with the ground and no roots.
8. Tops are to be left on.
9. PCPSL will again be collecting Show Cane entries from your farm with Frank logging the entries. To arrange collection please advise one of the PCPSL staff by NO LATER than 2pm Wednesday 29th July, 2026 with collection commencing from 8am on Thursday 30th July, 2026. Exhibits in classes 9012 and 9013 (CCS classes) with tops intact are to be picked up by PCPSL from 8am on Thursday 30th July, 2026 to be processed by SRA on that day. Alternatively cane for exhibition (not entered in classes 9012 and/or 9013) may be entered at the cane exhibit area up until 1.00pm on Friday 31st July, 2026 with the appropriate ticket fully completed.
10. The Ray Venton Memorial trophy will be awarded to the grower with the most exhibits in Classes 9001-9013.
11. Stewards and/or their immediate family members are permitted to enter exhibits in competition. All entries are judged anonymously to ensure fairness and impartiality

12. The judging committee may withhold first place where they consider that entries are not worthy of such an award and grant 2nd and 3rd ONLY. NB If one entry only is received in a class, this exhibit may be transferred to Any Other Variety.

13. The judging committee reserves the right to reject unsuitable exhibits. The final arbiter is the Chief Steward of the Show Cane Exhibition.

14. The Sarina Show Society reserves the right to substitute prize money for vouchers of the equivalent value.

Award Presentation Night

The presentation of awards won in the Sugar Cane section will be hosted at a function to be held on the 13th August, 2026 at 5pm at the Sarina Sporting & Services Club. Special guest invitations extended to sponsors, successful exhibitors, PCPSL Board members and staff will be sent out in the lead up to the event.

Entrants are reminded that filling in the relevant information on the tickets provided to accompany entries provides the Chief Steward and judges with all the relevant information to host an equitable and efficient competition.

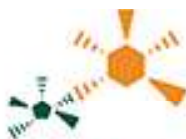

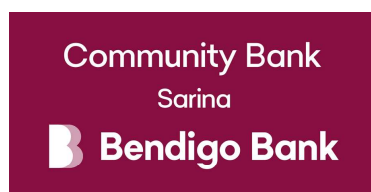
