Rules, Regulations and Acceptance of Entries

The following rules, regulations & acceptance of entries apply to all sections/competitions where applicable.

- Entries are accepted subject to the General Rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies (QCAS) and to the Constitution and Rules of this Society in addition to any Special Regulations which appear within this schedule.
- Every care will be taken of exhibits, but the Society shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits while at the Show or in transit to and from the grounds.
- All entries close on the dates shown in each respective section.
- No exhibit can be removed before 2pm on Sunday 4th August 2024 without permission of the Stewards in charge of the section.
- All exhibits must be the actual property of the exhibitor in whose name they are entered. The actual breeder of livestock exhibits to be given where possible.
- Exhibits entered in the wrong class may be transferred to the proper class by the judge.
- Persons in charge of exhibits or sideshows must obey the orders of the Management Committee or Stewards or they may be fined or ejected from the grounds.
- No person except Stewards, Officials, Judges and handlers (if required) shall be permitted to remain in yards, rings or pavilions during judging on any pretense whatsoever.

- Some Sections will be judged prior to the Show. These pavilions will be kept closed until Judging is completed.
- The judge may, at their discretion, refuse to award a prize where an exhibit is deemed by them to be not of sufficient merit.
- The judge's decision will be final and conclusive.
- Professional A professional is defined as someone who has qualifications in that field or is registered for GST.
- All prizes not claimed within thirty (30) days of closing date of Show will be considered to have lapsed and the amount will become a donation to the Society.
- All horses and other livestock, where practical, shall be paraded as directed by The Ring Steward. Exhibitors who do not comply may be fined at the discretion of the Stewards and any prizes won by their exhibits may be retained by the Society. The decision of the Ring Stewards to be final.
- Methods of counting points in trophies. Champion Awards will be counted three points as well a First Awards, Second Awards or Reserve Champion to count two points and Third Award to count one point. In the event of a tie for any place, the points awarded for the place and the next lower place shall be divided equally.
- The Sarina Showgrounds is a Glass Free venue, and the Show is a Glass Free event.

How to Enter Online

All entries are through Showday Online - https://showday.online/show/sarina

- 1. Create a new account or login to your account using your previous details if you have forgotten your password, please use the forgotten password feature.
 - 2. Select SARINA SHOW SOCIETY INC.
 - Click on PLACE AN ENTRY
 - 4. Click on INDIVIDUAL ENTRY
- 5. In Entrant Name select your Entrant from the drop down or click on ADD NEW to add a new entrant to your account.
 - 5a. If clicking Add New fill out your Entrants name. Other fields are optional.
 - 6. In EXHIBIT TYPE select INDOOR / DISPLAY.
 - 7. Click on SELECT CLASS.
 - 8. From the drop down choose the Section you would like to enter.
 - 9. On the pop up tick the box to accept the entry notes for this section.
 - 10. Click the PLUS symbol beside the section you are entering to expand to the classes.
 - 11. Click on the class or classes you are entering to select them.
 - 12. If entering multiple items into the same class, increase the QTY counter to reflect the number you would like to enter.
 - 13. Fill out the items name in the Exhibition Name box if applicable eg. Painting name.
 - 14. Fill in any additional information the show may require for this entry if asked.
 - 15. Once all classes have been selected.
 - 15a. Click on ADD ANOTHER ENTRY if you need to place more entries for this show and repeat this process.
- 16a. Click on FINISHED ADDING CLASSES if you do not need to place any more entries for this show.
 - 16. On the next screen select any extra items you need that are available.
 - 17. Click on FINISHED ADDING EXTRAS once done.
 - 18. Purchase Membership if required or Pay your membership invoice if showing.
 - 19. Click on FINISHED MEMBERSHIP once done.
 - 20. Tick the box to agree to our website T&C's.
 - 21. Click on payment type and enter any payment details as required.
 - 22. Click on PAY NOW.
- 23. You will be emailed an acknowledgement of your entries. Please check your Junk / Spam folder if this email is not in your inbox.

Section 4: STUD BEEF CATTLE

REGULATIONS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

Entry Fee: \$10.00 (includes Bedding Hay)

Prizes: 1st \$40; 2nd \$20; 3rd \$10 (unless otherwise stated)

Entries close: strictly Friday 26th July 2024 at 5pm (8 days prior to show)

Judging 8:00am sharp Saturday 3rd August 2024 with the non-led classes, led classes to follow.

- 1. The Stud Beef Cattle Section will be conducted as an "All Breeds" Competition.
- 2. The Chief Steward has the right, in consultation with the show management committee, to disqualify, and have removed from the grounds, exhibitors whose behaviour towards animals, fellow exhibitors, or volunteers is unacceptable. unruly behaviour will not be tolerated.
- 3. Led exhibits must be tied in the area provided by the Show Society for such purposes.
- 4. For safety reasons, all cattle are to remain in allotted stall area unless being washed or handled.
- 5. All cattle must be handled and tractable and led into the ring to the judge for judging and ribbons. All animals must be securely restrained in such a manner as to satisfy the Chief Steward's requirements.
- 6. All cattle must be fully registered with the respective breed societies and certificates must be available for inspection upon request by Chief Stewards or Show Society Executives.
- 7. The age of registered stud cattle is to be calculated from birth up to the 30th of June 2024. Please supply actual date of birth of each animal on each entry form.
- 8. Exhibits must be the bona-fide property of the Exhibitor in whose name they are entered and must have been for at least one month prior to the date of entries closing.
- 9. Bulls over 12 months of age must have a nose ring. Females over 12 months must have a nose ring or clip. All cattle must have 2 points of restraint at all times whilst handled on the show grounds. For safety reasons neck straps or neck chains must be used in stalls.
- 10. Any calf shown as part of a cow and calf unit is not to be shown in any other class.
- 11. Exhibits are to be polled, short scurs or dehorned.
- 12. Entry Forms and Entry Fees are to be lodged with The Secretary, Sarina Show Society Inc., PO Box 119, Sarina Qld 4737 or sarina.showsoc@bigpond.com.au
- 13. Entry Fees can be paid directly into the Show Society Bank Account. BSB: 633 000 Account Name: Sarina Show Society Account Number: 146 042 494 Reference: Entrant's Name
- 14. In all Stud Beef Classes each Exhibitor must state on the Entry Form all particulars of each animal entered; breed, animal's name/number, colour, date of birth, sire, dam and name and address of the Breeder, the Herd Book number of each animal (Exhibit and Parents). The responsibility for accuracy of description and pedigree and the eligibility of each animal entered rests with the Exhibitor.
- 15. All exhibits in the <u>Led</u> Stud Beef Cattle Section must be paraded for Judging. Whilst being led in either the Judging Ring or the Grand Parade, handlers must ensure that all animals are securely under control.
- 16. Prize Winners in all Classes of the Stud Beef Cattle Section must take part in the Grand Parade if held. The Exhibitor is to provide leaders for his/her exhibits, such leaders are to be neatly attired.
- 17. Prize Money and will be awarded to First, Second and Third Placing in Classes 4001 to 4028. Ribbons will be awarded from First to Fourth.
- 18. No Steward, Officer or Member of the Committee wearing the Society's badge shall lead, bring into the Ring or hold any exhibit before the Judge whilst the exhibit is being judged. Breach of this regulation shall disqualify the exhibit from competition.
- 19. No drug, hormone or tranquilizer shall be administered to any animal exhibit except under the direction of the Society's Veterinary Surgeon who shall advise the Stewards if in his opinion such drug, hormone or tranquilizer is likely to have any effect which would be material to its chances of being awarded a prize and in such case the Stewards may debar the animal from competition. A Steward may at any time direct the Society's Veterinary Surgeon to take a sample of blood, saliva or urine from any exhibit for testing.
- 20. Protests against wards must be lodged with The Secretary, in writing, within **fifteen** minutes of the announcement of placing in the contested Class. The protest is to be accompanied by a Bond of \$25.00.
- 21. Entries in led classes will not be eligible for non-led classes and vice versa.

- 22. New and/or boutique breeds are welcome to participate in their respective breed sections but are not eligible for major awards until commercial significance can be demonstrated, i.e. number of commercial animals through abattoirs or total numbers of the breed in the district or state.
- 23. Cattle are to be weighed and NLIS Scanned, a copy of NVDS must be supplied. All steers will be weighed on Friday Afternoon
- 24. The Show Society will not be responsible for any accident caused through, or by, an exhibit and will not under any circumstances hold itself responsible for any loss or miss-delivery of livestock or other exhibit of any kind, or for any damage done thereto.
- 25. Heifers exhibited in class 4031 & 4032 are not to be exhibited in any other class.
- 26. Per nomination forms please advise pens required for unled cattle as all pens will be allocated to ensure the judging runs sequentially.
- 27. All cattle are to be free of disease and ticks upon arrival.

RESERVE CHAMPION CALF BULL

- 28. Exhibits entered in the wrong class may be transferred to the proper class by the judge or steward.
- 29. Classes in this competition may be combined at the steward's discretion should there be insufficient numbers.
- 30. Exhibitors will be allocated passes handlers on the basis of one (1) pass per four (4) head of cattle presented. Passes must be collected by the exhibitor at the Show Office.


