Please Read Carefully

CONDITIONS:

1. Entries are accepted subject to the General Rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies (QCAS) and to the Constitution and Rules of this Society in addition to any Special Regulations which appear within this schedule.
2. All entry nominations for sections 23003 to 23026 are to be completed online and schoolwork lodged at the show office by 5.00pm on Friday 24th of July 2026. Late entries may be displayed (if space permits) but will not be judged.
3. Entries in Class 23001 and 23002 School "Displays" must be nominated by Wednesday 22nd July, 2026 and set up in the Main Pavilion no later than Wednesday 29th of July 2026, 5pm. If you are unable to do so within this time, please contact Section Steward, through the show office, to make arrangements. Space will be divided into two sections, kindergarten and primary school.
4. Class Tickets must be attached to all exhibits.
5. Exhibits must include the following information on the BACK of each entry:
6. School / Section/ Class/ Child's Name
7. Judging will be completed by Thursday 30th of July 2026.
8. Exhibits entered in previous Sarina Shows are not permitted to be entered into this year's Show.
9. Exhibitors may enter one exhibit in each class. All exhibits will be judged but in the event of numerous large exhibits in any one class, display cannot be guaranteed.
10. There is no limit of the number of entries which may be made by an exhibitor.
11. Provisions are made for awarding 1st, 2nd & 3rd place in each class. Judges may withhold any or all places if exhibits are not of an acceptable standard.
12. **All individual school artwork must be A4 in size; Posters not bigger than A4**
13. Exhibitors are not permitted to interfere with the judging process.
14. Every care will be taken of exhibits, but no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage.
15. Exhibits may be collected on Sunday, August 2nd after 9.00am to 12noon. Remaining entries will be available from the Show Office on Monday 3rd August between 9.00am and 4.00pm after which remaining items will be disposed of unless prior arrangements have been made with the Section Steward.
16. Stewards and/or their immediate family members are permitted to enter exhibits in competition. All entries are judged anonymously to ensure fairness and impartiality.
17. The Sarina Show Society reserves the right to substitute prize money for vouchers of the equivalent value.

While every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of this schedule, the Sarina Show Society reserves the right to correct any errors, omissions, or inaccuracies and to make amendments where necessary.

DISCLAIMER: The Sarina Show Society (SSS) shall not be responsible for any accident that may be caused to or by an exhibitor, members of the general public or competitor and will not, under any circumstances, be responsible for any losses or entries of any kind, or any injury or damage done thereby. Persons contravening any of SSS's rules/ regulations shall forfeit any prize awarded. SSS reserves the right to refuse or cancel, or require any entry to be removed at any time. Exhibitors shall accept the decision of the Stewards/Judges appointed by SSS as final. The decisions of the Sarina Show Society Committee are final.

SECTION 23

School Display Information (Classes 23001-23002)

1. Entry forms are not necessary for this section, however prior confirmation on school displays is required.
2. Exhibits must be clearly marked with the competitor's full name, school and class on the back of the exhibit.
3. Work is to be carried out under school supervision. No correction by teachers is to be evident.
4. One entry per pupil per class

Due to limited space, all schools must advise the Show Society by Friday 24th July, 2026 if they intend to enter a school display. Please email sarina.showsoc@bigpond.com.au

All exhibits are to be assembled on Wednesday 29th July, 2026 and must be completed by 5.00pm.

Entries are to cover no more than 3 square metres (depending on the number of schools entering) and are judged on the following criteria:-

Visual Impact

First and foremost, you want the public (and the judge) to spend longer in front of your school's exhibit than any other, so visual impact is very important.

Variety

Your exhibit should display a wide range of the activities which make your school an exceptional place for your pupils. Judges look at representation of a range of arts, crafts, schoolwork and activities. The use of a blend of traditional and computerised presentations, along with photographs of a range of pupil activities, will impress both the public and the judges. We want your exhibit to tell the story of the educational experiences enjoyed by the entire range of pupils at your school.

Context

Unobtrusive cards or labels should explain briefly the nature of each aspect of the display and indicate the year level involved. Kindergarten and preschool displays are most effective if they concentrate on a single theme for the main display, with a range of photographs illustrating the production process. Photographs, children's drawings and produced items can help to give a rounded picture of the educational experience you provide for your pupils.

The Role of the Pupils in the Display

Given the limited display space you are allocated, bear in mind that processes and products should be pupil centred, displaying pupil's experiences and achievements.

How to Enter the Pavilion Sections Online

All entries are to be submitted via Showday Online -
<https://showday.online/show/sarina>

1. Create a new account or login to your account using your previous details – if you have forgotten your password, please use the forgotten password feature.
2. Select SARINA SHOW SOCIETY INC.
3. Click on PLACE AN ENTRY
4. Click on INDIVIDUAL ENTRY
5. In Entrant Name select your Entrant from the drop down or click on ADD NEW to add a new entrant to your account.
* If clicking Add New fill out your Entrants name. Other fields are optional.
6. In EXHIBIT TYPE select INDOOR / DISPLAY.
7. Click on SELECT CLASS.
8. From the drop down choose the Section you would like to enter.
9. On the pop up tick the box to accept the entry notes for this section.
10. Click the PLUS symbol beside the section you are entering to expand to the classes.
11. Click on the class or classes you are entering to select them.
12. If entering multiple items into the same class, increase the QTY counter to reflect the number you would like to enter.
13. Fill out the items name in the Exhibition Name box if applicable eg. Painting name.
14. Fill in any additional information the show may require for this entry if asked.
15. Once all classes have been selected.

* Click on ADD ANOTHER ENTRY if you need to place more entries for this show and repeat this process.

* Click on FINISHED ADDING CLASSES if you do not need to place any more entries for this show.
16. On the next screen select any extra items you need that are available
.
17. Click on FINISHED ADDING EXTRAS once done.
18. Purchase Membership if required or Pay your membership invoice if showing.
19. Click on FINISHED MEMBERSHIP once done.
20. Tick the box to agree to our website T&C's.
21. Click on payment type and enter any payment details as required.
22. Click on PAY NOW.
