Sarina Show Cane - Rules and Regulations

- 1. All cane must appear on the approved varieties list for Plane Creek mill area in the year of exhibition.
- 2. All exhibits to be annual plant or ration cane unless specified in schedule. No Standover cane to be entered.
- 3. Judging Committee's decision will be final.
- 4. The Growers names to be displayed only after the completion of judging.
- 5. All entries to be properly presented and stripped NOT polished.
- 6. STALK entries must be cut level with the ground, and no roots.
- 7. Tops to be left on.
- 8. PCPSL will again be collecting Show Cane entries from your farm with Frank and Jessica logging the entries. To arrange collection please advise one of the PCPSL staff by NO LATER than 3.30pm on Thursday the 31st July 2025.
 - Alternatively cane for exhibition may be entered at the cane exhibit area up until 8.30 am on Saturday 2nd August 2025 with appropriate ticket fully completed.
 - Exhibits in Classes 9012 and 9013 (CCS CLASSES) with tops intact are to be picked up by P.C.P.S.L. on Friday the 1st August 2025 to be processed by SRA on Saturday 2nd August 2025.
- 9. The Ray Venton Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the grower with the most exhibits in Classes 9001-9013.
- 10. There is no entry fee applicable.
- 11. The Judging Committee may withhold first place where they consider that entries are not worthy of such an award and grant 2nd and 3rd place ONLY. NB If one entry only is received in a class, this exhibit may be transferred to Any Other Variety.
- 12. The Judging Committee reserves the right to reject unsuitable exhibits. The final arbiter is the Chief Steward of the Show Cane Exhibition.
