# Please Read Carefully

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1.Entries are accepted subject to the General Rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies (QCAS) and to the Constitution and Rules of the Sarina Show Society in addition to any Special Regulations which appear within this schedule.
- 2.Exhibits are to be polled or completely dehorned **with no sign of horn**.
- 3.Cattle are to be delivered to the Sarina Showgrounds no later than 1.00pm curfew on Friday 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2026. Judging will commence at 9am on Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2026.
- 4.Cattle must be NLIS compliant before arrival at the Sarina Showgrounds.
- 5.Relevant documentation, including NVD and National Feedlot Accreditation Scheme Delivery Docket (for grain fed cattle) are required.
- 6.Cattle should be free of ticks, but exhibitors should adhere to recommended withholding periods.
- 7.Handling of cattle after unloading at the Sarina Showgrounds will be at the discretion of the Chief Steward and agents. Cattle will be weighed, mouthed and tagged provided the owner, a representative or adequate instruction is available for cataloguing.
- 8.Cattle must be nominated to a class prior to release from the crush.
- 9.The Chief Steward has the power to transfer entries to appropriate classes.
- 10.Judging will be based on market suitability, conformation, finish and optimum weight for age. If the judge decides that an exhibit is not worthy of a prize, no prize will be awarded.
- 11.Sarina Show Society yard dues will be waived (due to paying an entry fee for each class), however agents commission will still apply.
- 12.A maximum of 2 entries per PIC are permitted./per brand
- 13.Entry fees and agents commission will be deducted from the auction proceeds.
- 14.Prize money, sashes and/or trophies will be awarded for per the Schedule.
- 15.Champions will be selected from first prize winners in eligible classes.
- 16.The decision of the Chief Steward and/or judge is final in all matters relating to the conduct of this section. Any protests against awards must be lodged in writing with The Secretary, within 15 minutes of the announcement of judging in the contested class. The protest must be accompanied by a fee of \$25.00.
- 17.An auction sale will be conducted on Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2026. The auction will commence between 1pm and 3pm, or at such later time as the Chief Steward may decide on the day. Conditions of sale will be the same as any other livestock auction held at the Sarina Showgrounds. All entries in Prime Beef Classes 3001-3014 must be offered for sale at the auction. The owners of "passed in" cattle at the auction shall be liable for the applicable commission. Vendors should advise the stewards and/or auctioneers of reserve prices prior the sale.
- 18.Only cattle entered in the show are eligible to be auctioned.
- 19.No cattle are to be removed from the Sarina Showgrounds until 9am Sunday morning, 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2026 or at the Stewards discretion.
- 20.Every care will be taken of exhibits, but the Society shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits while at the Show or in transit to and from the grounds.
- 21.All exhibits must be the actual property of the exhibitor in whose name they are entered.
- 22.Persons in charge of exhibits must obey the orders of the Management Committee or Stewards or they may be fined or ejected from the grounds.
- 23.Stewards and/or their immediate family members are permitted to enter exhibits in competition. All entries are judged anonymously to ensure fairness and impartiality.
