## Please Read Carefully

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entries are accepted subject to the General Rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies (QCAS) and to the Constitution and Rules of the Sarina Show Society in addition to any Special Regulations which appear within this schedule.
2. Every care will be taken with exhibits, but the Society shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits while at the Show or in transit to and from the grounds.
3. All entries close on the date shown above.
4. No exhibit can be removed before 9am on Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> August, 2026, without permission of the Steward in charge of the relevant section.
5. All exhibits must be the original work of the exhibitor in whose name they are entered.
6. An exhibit that has won a prize at a previous Sarina Show is not eligible for entry.
7. Competitors are restricted to two (2) entries per class.
8. Each exhibit must be clearly marked with the entrant's name, section and class on the back of the artwork. This information can be printed from Showday Online at the time of placing your entry online.
9. Exhibits entered in the incorrect class may be transferred to the proper class by the Steward and/or Judge.
10. No exhibitors shall be permitted to remain in the pavilion during judging.
11. The Judge may at their discretion, refuse to award a prize where an exhibit is deemed by them to be not of sufficient merit.
12. The Judge's decision will be final.
13. All prizes not claimed by 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2026 will be considered to have lapsed and the amount will become a donation to the Society.
14. Stewards and/or their immediate family members are permitted to enter exhibits in competition. All entries are judged anonymously to ensure fairness and impartiality.
15. Prize money can be collected from the show office between 3.00pm to 5.00pm on Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> August 2026 and between 9.00am to 12 noon on Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> August, 2026 (or at a time arranged with the office).
16. All prize money is to be collected by 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2026. Any prize money not collected by this date will be donated back to the Sarina Show Society.
17. Exhibitors wishing to sell their produce/exhibits (except cookery) and donate the proceeds to the Show Society, can do so by writing "For Sale" on the entry form.
18. The Sarina Show Society reserves the right to substitute prize money for vouchers of the equivalent value.

While every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of this schedule, the Sarina Show Society reserves the right to correct any errors, omissions, or inaccuracies and to make amendments where necessary.

# How to Enter the Pavilion Sections Online

All entries are to be submitted via Showday Online -  
<https://showday.online/show/sarina>

1. Create a new account or login to your account using your previous details – if you have forgotten your password, please use the forgotten password feature.
2. Select SARINA SHOW SOCIETY INC.
3. Click on PLACE AN ENTRY
4. Click on INDIVIDUAL ENTRY
5. In Entrant Name select your Entrant from the drop down or click on ADD NEW to add a new entrant to your account.  
\* If clicking Add New fill out your Entrants name. Other fields are optional.
6. In EXHIBIT TYPE select INDOOR / DISPLAY.
7. Click on SELECT CLASS.
8. From the drop down choose the Section you would like to enter.
9. On the pop up tick the box to accept the entry notes for this section.
10. Click the PLUS symbol beside the section you are entering to expand to the classes.
11. Click on the class or classes you are entering to select them.
12. If entering multiple items into the same class, increase the QTY counter to reflect the number you would like to enter.
13. Fill out the items name in the Exhibition Name box if applicable eg. Painting name.
14. Fill in any additional information the show may require for this entry if asked.
15. Once all classes have been selected.  
  
\* Click on ADD ANOTHER ENTRY if you need to place more entries for this show and repeat this process.  
  
\* Click on FINISHED ADDING CLASSES if you do not need to place any more entries for this show.
16. On the next screen select any extra items you need that are available
17. Click on FINISHED ADDING EXTRAS once done.
18. Purchase Membership if required or Pay your membership invoice if showing.
19. Click on FINISHED MEMBERSHIP once done.
20. Tick the box to agree to our website T&C's.
21. Click on payment type and enter any payment details as required.
22. Click on PAY NOW.
