# Rules, Regulations and Acceptance of Entries

The following rules, regulations & acceptance of entries apply to all sections/competitions where applicable.

- Entries are accepted subject to the General Rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies (QCAS) and to the Constitution and Rules of this Society in addition to any Special Regulations which appear within this schedule.
- Every care will be taken of exhibits, but the Society shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits while at the Show or in transit to and from the grounds.
- All entries close on the dates shown in each respective section.
- No exhibit can be removed before 2pm on Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> August 2024 without permission of the Stewards in charge of the section.
- All exhibits must be the actual property of the exhibitor in whose name they are entered. The actual breeder of livestock exhibits to be given where possible.
- Exhibits entered in the wrong class may be transferred to the proper class by the judge.
- Persons in charge of exhibits or sideshows must obey the orders of the Management Committee or Stewards or they may be fined or ejected from the grounds.
- No person except Stewards, Officials, Judges and handlers (if required) shall be permitted to remain in yards, rings or pavilions during judging on any pretense whatsoever.
- Some Sections will be judged prior to the Show. These pavilions will be kept closed until Judging is completed.
- The judge may, at their discretion, refuse to award a prize where an exhibit is deemed by them to be not of sufficient merit.
- The judge's decision will be final and conclusive.
- Professional – A professional is defined as someone who has qualifications in that field or is registered for GST.
- All prizes not claimed within thirty (30) days of closing date of Show will be considered to have lapsed and the amount will become a donation to the Society.
- All horses and other livestock, where practical, shall be paraded as directed by The Ring Steward. Exhibitors who do not comply may be fined at the discretion of the Stewards and any prizes won by their exhibits may be retained by the Society. The decision of the Ring Stewards to be final.
- Methods of counting points in trophies. Champion Awards will be counted three points as well a First Awards, Second Awards or Reserve Champion to count two points and Third Award to count one point. In the event of a tie for any place, the points awarded for the place and the next lower place shall be divided equally.
- The Sarina Showgrounds is a Glass Free venue, and the Show is a Glass Free event.

# How to Enter the Poultry Sections Online

All entries are through Showday Online - <https://showday.online/show/sarina>

1. Create a new account or login to your account using your previous details – if you have forgotten your password, please use the forgotten password feature.
  2. Select SARINA SHOW SOCIETY INC.
  3. Click on PLACE AN ENTRY
  4. Click on INDIVIDUAL ENTRY
5. In Entrant Name select your Entrant from the drop down or click on ADD NEW to add a new entrant to your account.
  - 5a. If clicking Add New fill out your Entrants name. Other fields are optional.
  6. In EXHIBIT TYPE select INDOOR / DISPLAY.
  7. Click on SELECT CLASS.
  8. From the drop down choose the Section you would like to enter.
  9. On the pop up tick the box to accept the entry notes for this section.
10. Click the PLUS symbol beside the section you are entering to expand to the classes.
  11. Click on the class or classes you are entering to select them.
12. If entering multiple items into the same class, increase the QTY counter to reflect the number you would like to enter.
13. Fill out the items name in the Exhibition Name box if applicable eg. Painting name.
14. Fill in any additional information the show may require for this entry if asked.
  15. Once all classes have been selected.
- 15a. Click on ADD ANOTHER ENTRY if you need to place more entries for this show and repeat this process.
- 16a. Click on FINISHED ADDING CLASSES if you do not need to place any more entries for this show.
  16. On the next screen select any extra items you need that are available.
  17. Click on FINISHED ADDING EXTRAS once done.
18. Purchase Membership if required or Pay your membership invoice if showing.
  19. Click on FINISHED MEMBERSHIP once done.
  20. Tick the box to agree to our website T&C's.
  21. Click on payment type and enter any payment details as required.
  22. Click on PAY NOW.

# Poultry & Pigeons

## SPECIAL POULTRY AND PIGEON REGULATIONS

(For the conduct of Poultry and Caged Bird competitions at QCAS affiliated Queensland Agricultural Shows)

Subject to the Rules, By-Laws and Regulations of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Society's Inc (QCAS) and the Society/Association relevant to this schedule, the following General Poultry and Pigeon Regulations shall apply.

**These regulations are to be read in conjunction with the General Regulations contained in this schedule.**

### 1. NOTICE TO INTENDING EXHIBITORS

1. Birds can only be removed from showing area with the permission of the Chief Steward
2. Any Bird entered in the incorrect class can, at the discretion of the Chief Steward, be re-entered in the correct class.
3. No birds to be removed or handled without the Steward's permission.
4. Any Bird found to have been tampered with may, at the discretion of the Stewards and Committee, be disqualified.
5. Eggs remain the property of the affiliated Agricultural Society.
6. No trimming, plucking or dyeing of feathers, staining of legs or any fraudulent practice will be allowed.
7. Every exhibitor will be deemed responsible for the condition in which his/her exhibit appears in the pen. It shall be permissible for Exhibitors to dub male game fowl and game bantams.
8. Birds must be true to breed, no cross breeds.
9. Banded birds are eligible for judging.
10. Junior Exhibitors must pen and unpen their own entries.

### 2. AGE OF EXHIBITS

1. Birds 12 months and over will be judged as adults.

### 3. JUDGING

1. Judging standards will be those recognized by the Australian Standard or the British Poultry Standard where applicable.
2. Exhibitors are not to talk to Judges during judging.
3. Judges are not to judge classes in which they have entered.
4. An Exhibitor shall not compete nor show any bird in a section if the bird has been owned or leased by the Judge or a member of the Judge's immediate family or if the Judge is the Exhibitor's employer or business partner.
5. An Exhibitor shall not compete if the Exhibitor or any bird being shown by the Exhibitor has been given tuition by the Judge or the Judge's business partner within three (3) months prior to or during the show.
6. An Exhibitor is ineligible to compete, if the Exhibitor has employed or has been employed by or has been a business partner of the Judge of the Section within three (3) months prior to or during the holding of the show.
7. A Judge shall not visit the bird-housing complex of the Agricultural Society, nor the owners, nor inspect or discuss any animal entered in the Show prior to or during the judging of the relevant section.

### 4. BIOSECURITY

1. All QCAS affiliated agricultural societies have developed a comprehensive *Agricultural Show Biosecurity Plan* and all event organizers, competitors and spectators have a joint responsibility to ensure the successful implementation of a biosecurity plan.

## Regulations and Condition of Entry

1. Entries are accepted subject to the Rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies and Regulations of the Sarina Show Society Inc.
2. Classes will be formed for all Breeds mentioned only where there are three (3) or more of a breed, otherwise exhibits will be placed in AOV/AOC Classes. In AOV/AOC Classes where there are three (3) or more exhibits of any one Breed, separate Classes will be provided for that Breed.
3. Breed Champions: Where there are fourteen (14) or more exhibits of a Breed, male or females will be judged separately for individual awards.
4. Only birds entered in Single Classes are eligible for single Championships.
5. Only Judges, Stewards and Adult Exhibitors will be permitted in the Pavilion during Judging. Exhibitors are not to talk to Judges during Judging.
6. No person is permitted to handle or use Judging Sticks on any other exhibitor's birds, exhibitors can handle and use Judging Sticks on their own exhibits up to completion of penning birds. After completion of penning, no birds can be handled or have Judging Sticks used without the permission of the Chief Steward or Judge. This rule is enforced most seriously and endorsed by the FCAQ (Qld).
7. All Birds to be free of Lice and disease.
8. No birds are allowed to have leg bands.
9. Exhibits must be the property of the Exhibitor.
10. Any birds found to have been tampered with may, at the discretion of the Stewards and Committee, be disqualified. Should any dispute arise for which there is no general rule the matter in dispute will be referred to the committee and their decision will be final.
11. Birds can be penned between 5.00pm and 6.30pm Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2024 and 7.00am and 8.30am on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2024.
12. **BIRDS CAN ONLY BE REMOVED FROM THE SHOWING AREA WITH PERMISSION OF THE CHIEF STEWARD.**
13. 20 entries or more receive a **FREE PASS**. Entries must be in and paid for by Entries Close 26th July 2024 to receive this pass.
14. All prize money is to be collected from the Sarina Show Society Office from 12 noon on Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> August 2024. Any money not collected by the end of August 2024 will be donated back to the Sarina Show Society.

**Entry Fee:** \$1.00 per entry per class

**Entries Close:** Friday 26<sup>th</sup> July 2024 - NO late entries will be accepted.

**Exhibits Accepted:** The Poultry Pavilion will be open for penning between 5.00pm and 6.30pm on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2024 and from 7.00am and 8.30am on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2024.

**Prize Money:** Unless otherwise specified

1st - \$5.00

2nd - \$3.00 - No 2nd prize money if less than four (4) entries

Breed Champion - \$5.00 – four (4) or more entries

**Judging:** To commence at 9.00am Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2024

**Exhibit Collection:** Birds can be reclaimed between Noon and 2.00pm on Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> August 2024.

**Open to Public on Saturday from 8.00am - 7.00pm and Sunday from 8.00am - 2.00pm**
