

Rules, Regulations and Acceptance of Entries

The following rules, regulations & acceptance of entries apply to all sections/competitions where applicable.

- Entries are accepted subject to the General Rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies (QCAS) and to the Constitution and Rules of this Society in addition to any Special Regulations which appear within this schedule.
- Every care will be taken of exhibits, but the Society shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits while at the Show or in transit to and from the grounds.
- All entries close on the dates shown in each respective section.
- No exhibit can be removed before 2pm on Sunday 3rd August 2025 without permission of the Stewards in charge of the section.
- All exhibits must be the actual property of the exhibitor in whose name they are entered. The actual breeder of livestock exhibits to be given where possible.
- Exhibits entered in the wrong class may be transferred to the proper class by the judge.
- Persons in charge of exhibits or sideshows must obey the orders of the Management Committee or Stewards or they may be fined or ejected from the grounds.
- No person except Stewards, Officials, Judges and handlers (if required) shall be permitted to remain in yards, rings or pavilions during judging on any pretense whatsoever.
- Some Sections will be judged prior to the Show. These pavilions will be kept closed until Judging is completed.
- The judge may, at their discretion, refuse to award a prize where an exhibit is deemed by them to be not of sufficient merit.
- The judge's decision will be final and conclusive.
- Professional – A professional is defined as someone who has qualifications in that field or is registered for GST.
- All prizes not claimed within thirty (30) days of closing date of Show will be considered to have lapsed and the amount will become a donation to the Society.
- All horses and other livestock, where practical, shall be paraded as directed by The Ring Steward. Exhibitors who do not comply may be fined at the discretion of the Stewards and any prizes won by their exhibits may be retained by the Society. The decision of the Ring Stewards to be final.
- Methods of counting points in trophies. Champion Awards will be counted three points as well a First Awards, Second Awards or Reserve Champion to count two points and Third Award to count one point. In the event of a tie for any place, the points awarded for the place and the next lower place shall be divided equally.
- The Sarina Showgrounds is a Glass Free venue, and the Show is a Glass Free event.

How to Enter Online

All entries are through Showday Online - <https://showday.online/show/sarina>

1. Create a new account or login to your account using your previous details – if you have forgotten your password, please use the forgotten password feature.
2. Select SARINA SHOW SOCIETY INC.
3. Click on PLACE AN ENTRY
4. Click on INDIVIDUAL ENTRY
5. In Entrant Name select your Entrant from the drop down or click on ADD NEW to add a new entrant to your account.
 - 5a. If clicking Add New fill out your Entrants name. Other fields are optional.
6. In EXHIBIT TYPE select INDOOR / DISPLAY.
7. Click on SELECT CLASS.
8. From the drop down choose the Section you would like to enter.
9. On the pop up tick the box to accept the entry notes for this section.
10. Click the PLUS symbol beside the section you are entering to expand to the classes.
 11. Click on the class or classes you are entering to select them.
12. If entering multiple items into the same class, increase the QTY counter to reflect the number you would like to enter.
13. Fill out the items name in the Exhibition Name box if applicable eg. Painting name.
14. Fill in any additional information the show may require for this entry if asked.
15. Once all classes have been selected.
- 15a. Click on ADD ANOTHER ENTRY if you need to place more entries for this show and repeat this process.
- 16a. Click on FINISHED ADDING CLASSES if you do not need to place any more entries for this show.
 16. On the next screen select any extra items you need that are available.
 17. Click on FINISHED ADDING EXTRAS once done.
18. Purchase Membership if required or Pay your membership invoice if showing.
 19. Click on FINISHED MEMBERSHIP once done.
 20. Tick the box to agree to our website T&C's.
21. Click on payment type and enter any payment details as required.
 22. Click on PAY NOW.
23. You will be emailed an acknowledgement of your entries. Please check your Junk / Spam folder if this email is not in your inbox.

Section 1: RING EVENTS

Regulations and Conditions of Entry

- 1) All competitors and exhibitors must pay to enter the Showgrounds.
- 2) Any competitor or exhibitor who wishes to lodge a Protest shall do so in writing accompanied by a Bond of \$50.00 within one (1) hour of completion of the Event to main office. The Chief Ring Stewards decision is final.
- 3) It shall be a condition of entry that the Sarina Show Society Inc. will not be responsible for any accident to any exhibit at the show.
- 4) All horses are to be always under complete control, failure to do so may result in being asked to leave the show grounds for the safety of patrons.
- 5) Only competitors and Officials are allowed in the Ring during Judging.
- 6) Competitors, Handlers, Grooms and Others in charge of Exhibits must conform to all directions given by the Stewards. Failure to comply may result in a Fine and or ejection from the Showgrounds.
- 7) Judges may decline to make Awards where entries are of insufficient merit.
- 8) Prize money will be paid at completion of each class.
- 9) Any colt or stallion two years and over shall be led with safe and secure equipment.
- 10) Stallions may compete in Halter Classes, Dressage, Western Performance Events, and where specified.
- 11) If numbers permit, Classes may be split at the Chief Ring Steward's discretion.
- 12) On the occasion of a clash of events for a competitor, he/she must decide which event he/she intends to enter. All competitors will receive three (3) calls only. Latecomers may not be accepted. Program times can only be altered at the discretion of the Chief Ring Steward.
- 13) All entries are accepted subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies and the By-Laws of the Sarina Show Society Inc.
- 14) The Executive Committee reserves the right to alter, amend or cancel this Schedule at any time and without notice.
- 15) Registration Papers must be presented on request.
- 16) Nominations as specified in the Schedule will be by Pre-Nomination, this can be done by either of the following methods:

 - b) Payment will be accepted at the Show Office two week prior to the show.

There will be no refund for unused tickets, Pre-nomination closes Monday 28th July 2025. Late nominations will incur double entry fees
- 17) Random blood samples/urine samples may be taken at any time by the Society's Veterinary Surgeon to test for prohibited substances.
- 18) All Riders who wish to compete in any event **MUST** sign an **INDEMNITY** form **PRIOR** to entering any classes. A HORSE HEALTH DECLARATION FORM MUST ALSO BE COMPLETED AND SIGNED. Forms available at ticket office. **NO INDEMNITY/HORSE HEALTH FORM - NO ENTRY TO CLASSES.**
- 19) **Free gate entry will be issued to the rider (not handler) only if prenominated.**



DRESSAGE

1st August 2025

Entry Conditions:

- This is a Closed restricted club event
- Club Classes 1-7 require club membership of Sarina Western Performance and Equestrian Club (SWPEC). SWPEC offers a day membership to be completed during nomination.
- This competition is to be run under 2025 EA rules. **No late nominations will be accepted.**
- Riders compete at their own risk – neither the organizing committee of any competition to which these rules apply, nor the EA accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, grounds, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
- It is the responsibility of all riders to familiarize themselves with the current EA rules and compulsory dress regulations relating to competitions and the current EA tests.
- The committee reserves the right to alter, amend or cancel any event in the schedule at any time without notice.
- All dogs must always be kept on a leash at your campsite.
- Electric fences are not allowed.
- Stables must be left clean.
- Horse Health Declaration must be presented on arrival at the grounds.
- Horses may only compete in 2 consecutive levels of dressage.
- Maximum of 2 dressage tests per horse per day.
- Any rider may ride a maximum of 2 horses in the one Dressage Class
- Due to cancellations, dressage test times may vary, please be ready when called.
- As per EA Hot Weather Policy – in the event of extremely hot weather the higher-level classes will be run in the cooler part of the day.
- Horse to be ridden by the same rider for the duration of the event.
- Closed Restricted Classes – open to registered / unregistered horses but if registered, horses must be ridden at their correct grading level or HC.
- Junior Rider – 16 years & under as of 1 January 2025
- Competitors must present themselves to the gear steward before each dressage test. This is not a gear safety check – riders are responsible for the condition and safety of their own equipment.
- Dress Standard – minimum acceptable for all competitors. Current approved standard helmet must be worn.

Jodhpurs or breeches – Dressage riders may wear any light color. **White saddle pads are required.**
Long sleeved shirt and tie or rat catcher collar for all riders. Jackets acceptable. Strictly no short-sleeved shirts. Dressage riders must wear gloves in all tests. Horse must have a noseband. Check EA Dressage rules for type.
