

Rules, Regulations and Acceptance of Entries

The following rules, regulations & acceptance of entries apply to all sections/competitions where applicable.

- Entries are accepted subject to the General Rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies (QCAS) and to the Constitution and Rules of this Society in addition to any Special Regulations which appear within this schedule.
- Every care will be taken of exhibits, but the Society shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits while at the Show or in transit to and from the grounds.
- All entries close on the dates shown in each respective section.
- No exhibit can be removed before 2pm on Sunday 4th August 2024 without permission of the Stewards in charge of the section.
- All exhibits must be the actual property of the exhibitor in whose name they are entered. The actual breeder of livestock exhibits to be given where possible.
- Exhibits entered in the wrong class may be transferred to the proper class by the judge.
- Persons in charge of exhibits or sideshows must obey the orders of the Management Committee or Stewards or they may be fined or ejected from the grounds.
- No person except Stewards, Officials, Judges and handlers (if required) shall be permitted to remain in yards, rings or pavilions during judging on any pretense whatsoever.
- Some Sections will be judged prior to the Show. These pavilions will be kept closed until Judging is completed.
- The judge may, at their discretion, refuse to award a prize where an exhibit is deemed by them to be not of sufficient merit.
- The judge's decision will be final and conclusive.
- Professional – A professional is defined as someone who has qualifications in that field or is registered for GST.
- All prizes not claimed within thirty (30) days of closing date of Show will be considered to have lapsed and the amount will become a donation to the Society.
- All horses and other livestock, where practical, shall be paraded as directed by The Ring Steward. Exhibitors who do not comply may be fined at the discretion of the Stewards and any prizes won by their exhibits may be retained by the Society. The decision of the Ring Stewards to be final.
- Methods of counting points in trophies. Champion Awards will be counted three points as well as First Awards, Second Awards or Reserve Champion to count two points and Third Award to count one point. In the event of a tie for any place, the points awarded for the place and the next lower place shall be divided equally.
- The Sarina Showgrounds is a Glass Free venue, and the Show is a Glass Free event.

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How to Enter the Pavilion Sections Online

All entries are through Showday Online - <https://showday.online/show/sarina>

1. Create a new account or login to your account using your previous details – if you have forgotten your password, please use the forgotten password feature.
 2. Select SARINA SHOW SOCIETY INC.
 3. Click on PLACE AN ENTRY
 4. Click on INDIVIDUAL ENTRY
5. In Entrant Name select your Entrant from the drop down or click on ADD NEW to add a new entrant to your account.
 - 5a. If clicking Add New fill out your Entrants name. Other fields are optional.
6. In EXHIBIT TYPE select INDOOR / DISPLAY.
 7. Click on SELECT CLASS.
 8. From the drop down choose the Section you would like to enter.
 9. On the pop up tick the box to accept the entry notes for this section.
10. Click the PLUS symbol beside the section you are entering to expand to the classes.
 11. Click on the class or classes you are entering to select them.
12. If entering multiple items into the same class, increase the QTY counter to reflect the number you would like to enter.
13. Fill out the items name in the Exhibition Name box if applicable eg. Painting name.
14. Fill in any additional information the show may require for this entry if asked.
 15. Once all classes have been selected.
- 15a. Click on ADD ANOTHER ENTRY if you need to place more entries for this show and repeat this process.
- 16a. Click on FINISHED ADDING CLASSES if you do not need to place any more entries for this show.
 16. On the next screen select any extra items you need that are available.
 17. Click on FINISHED ADDING EXTRAS once done.
18. Purchase Membership if required or Pay your membership invoice if showing.
 19. Click on FINISHED MEMBERSHIP once done.
 20. Tick the box to agree to our website T&C's.
 21. Click on payment type and enter any payment details as required.
 22. Click on PAY NOW.
23. You will be emailed an acknowledgement of your entries. Please check your Junk / Spam folder if this email is not in your inbox.

**Entries invited from schools, to cover an area of Approx. Three (3) square meters
(Depending on how many schools) and are judged on the following criteria:**

VISUAL IMPACT: First and foremost you want the Public, (and the Judge) to spend
Longer in front of your School's Exhibit than any other, so visual impact is very important.

VARIETY: Your Exhibit should display a wide range of the activities which make you're
School an exceptional place for your pupils. Judges look for representation of a range
of arts, crafts, school work and activities. The use of a blend of traditional and computerized
presentations, along with photographs of a range of pupil activities, will impress both the public and the
judges. We want your exhibit to tell the story of the educational experiences enjoyed by the entire range
of pupils at your School.

CONTEXT: Unobtrusive cards or labels should explain briefly the nature of each aspect
Of the display and indicate the year level involved. Kindergarten and Pre-School displays
Are most effective if they concentrate on a single theme for the main display, with a
range of photographs illustrating the production process. Photographs, children's drawings
and produced items can help to give a rounded picture of the educational experience you
provide for your pupils.

THE ROLE OF THE PUPILS IN THE DISPLAY: Given the limited display space you are allocated, bear in mind
that processes and products should be pupil centered, displaying pupils' experiences and achievements.

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
